The Electors and Ratepayers of the Town and Parish of St. Peter Port at a meeting held this day in pursuance of the foregoing publication have:

**Voted** the amount of £646,765.00 which together with the Ecclesiastical needs of £48,780.00 totaling ~~£695,545.00~~ to be levied by means of Owner's Rate at a rate of **18.31 pence** per TRP unit.

**Approved** the said Owner's Rate together with that approved at the meeting convened by the Rector and Churchwardens shall be levied by applying the relative factors to the TRP unit value of the Cadastre categories as published.

**Voted** the amount of **£708,859.00** to be levied by means of Refuse Rate as a standard charge of **£79.34** per habitable unit for the current year after due explanation having been given.
